A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Harford County - Hosanna School

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$186,227,
- 4 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Commissioners of the Harford
- 5 County Historic Preservation Commission for certain development or
- 6 improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject
- 7 to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund;
- 8 requiring the grantee to grant and convey a certain easement to the Maryland
- 9 Historical Trust; prohibiting the use of the proceeds of the sale of the bonds and
- the matching fund for sectarian religious purposes; and providing generally for
- the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 13 MARYLAND, That:
- 14 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 15 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Harford
- 16 County Hosanna School Loan of 2001 in a total principal amount equal to the lesser
- 17 of (i) \$186,227 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance with
- 18 Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of
- 19 State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public
- 20 Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of
- 21 the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 22 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 23 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 24 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 25 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 26 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 27 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 28 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 29 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 30 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Commissioners of the
- 31 Harford County Historic Preservation Commission (referred to hereafter in this Act

- 1 as "the grantee") for the planning, design, construction, reconstruction, and capital 2 equipping of the Hosanna School, located in Berkley, Maryland.
- 3 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 4 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 5 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 6 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 7 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- $8\,$ purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 9 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 10 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 11 unappropriated. The fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds
- 12 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount
- 13 of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the
- 14 Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final.
- 15 The grantee has until June 1, 2003, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of
- 16 Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is
- 17 presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to
- 18 the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching
- 19 fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan
- 20 in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works
- 21 shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 22 (6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey
- 23 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of
- 24 its interest:
- 25 (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- 26 and
- 27 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic
- 28 structures.
- 29 (b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust
- 30 and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.
- No portion of the proceeds of the loan or any of the matching funds may be
- 32 used for the furtherance of sectarian religious instruction, or in connection with the
- 33 design, acquisition, or construction of any building used or to be used as a place of
- 34 sectarian religious worship or instruction, or in connection with any program or
- 35 department of divinity for any religious denomination. Upon the request of the Board
- 36 of Public Works, the grantee shall submit evidence satisfactory to the Board that none
- 37 of the proceeds of the loan or any matching funds have been or are being used for a
- 38 purpose prohibited by this Act.
- 39 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 40 June 1, 2001.
