3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Charles County Board of License Commissioners
4 to issue a special Class B-B\&B (bed and breakfast) on-sale beer, wine and 5 liquor license; establishing the qualifications for the license; authorizing a Class $6 \quad$ B-B\&B licensee to sell alcoholic beverages to certain persons; establishing annual fees for the license; establishing the hours and days for sale for the license; authorizing the Board to adopt certain regulations; establishing that the license is void under certain circumstances; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the Class B-B\&B (bed and breakfast) license in Charles County.
