- 6 B-B&B licensee to sell alcoholic beverages to certain persons; establishing annual fees for the license; establishing the hours and days for sale for the 7
- 8 license; authorizing the Board to adopt certain regulations; establishing that the
- license is void under certain circumstances; defining a certain term; and 9
- generally relating to the Class B-B&B (bed and breakfast) license in Charles 10

## **HOUSE BILL 345**

- 1 (VII) THE HOURS AND DAYS FOR SALE UNDER THE LICENSE SHALL 2 BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 11-509 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 3 (VIII) AN APPLICANT FOR A CLASS B-B&B LICENSE SHALL MEET ALL
- 4 OTHER QUALIFICATIONS TO HOLD AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE IN THE
- 5 COUNTY.
- 6 (IV) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS
- 7 CONSISTENT WITH THIS PARAGRAPH.
- 8 (X) IF THE LICENSED PREMISES CEASES TO BE OPERATED AS A
- 9 BED AND BREAKFAST ESTABLISHMENT, THE LICENSE IS VOID.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 11 October 1, 2001.
