A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Charles County - Alcoholic Beverages - Public Golf Courses**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing in Charles County an alcoholic beverages licensee to
4 sell and a person to consume alcoholic beverages allowed under the license on
5 the grounds of a public golf course; making a certain stylistic change; and
6 generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Charles County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

15 8-502.

16 (a) This section applies only in Charles County.

17 (b) A licensee may sell and a person may consume alcoholic beverages
18 [permitted by] ALLOWED UNDER the license on the grounds of any PUBLICLY OR
19 privately owned golf course.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 June 1, 2001.
