Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

16 (a) This section applies only in Charles County.

17 (b) A licensee may sell and a person may consume alcoholic beverages

18 [permitted by] ALLOWED UNDER the license on the grounds of any PUBLICLY OR19 privately owned golf course.
