14 15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20	(a) (1) The local department in each county shall have a board, appointed as hereinafter provided and herein referred to as the local board. Except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection, the local board shall be composed of nine members. The members shall receive no salary for their services, but their reasonable expenses

- 1 incurred in attending meetings or performing other official duties shall be paid. Each
- 2 local board shall select its own chairman on July 1st of each year.
- 3 (2) Each local board chairman shall serve as liaison between the local
- 4 board and the State Board.
- 5 (3) (I) In Frederick County and in Garrett County, the local board
- 6 shall be composed of at least 9 but no more than 13 members, as determined by the
