## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

#### Home Builders - Performance Bonds

3 FOR the purpose of requiring home builders to post a certain performance bond to

4 cover expenses incurred by the owner of a new home if the home builder fails to

5 complete the new home or if there is extreme delay in the completion of the new

6 home; requiring the Consumer Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney

7 General to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to home builders.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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### **Article - Business Regulation**

16 4.5-302.

17 (a) Each person that constructs new homes for sale to the public shall18 maintain general liability insurance for at least \$100,000.

19 (b) If a home builder's registration has been revoked and the home builder

20 applies for a new registration, the Unit shall, in its discretion, approve the application

21 on the applicant's fulfillment of specified terms and conditions, including the posting

22 of a bond for the benefit of subcontractors, suppliers, and consumers, and the

23 payment of any judgments or awards due to any subcontractors, suppliers, and

24 consumers, for a period of 4 years from the date of the approval of registration, after

25 which the licensing bond shall expire and shall no longer be required to be

26 maintained by the registered home builder.

#### HOUSE BILL 360

1(C)(1)NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A HOME2BUILDER SHALL POST A PERFORMANCE BOND FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE OWNER OF3A NEW HOME TO COVER ANY EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE OWNER IF:

(I) THE HOME BUILDER FAILS TO COMPLETE THE NEW HOME; OR

5 (II) THERE IS EXTREME DELAY IN THE COMPLETION OF THE NEW 6 HOME.

7 (2) THE DIVISION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR THE 8 ADMINISTRATION OF THIS SUBSECTION.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2001.

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
