18 19	(e) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, a retiree, or a beneficiary of a retiree, who retires on or before June 30, 1999 with a service retirement allowance, shall receive an annual retirement allowance adjustment as of July 1, [1999, as follows:] 2001, EQUALING 13% OF THE RETIREE'S OR BENEFICIARY'S CURRENT RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE.
