1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Criminal Procedure - Sex Offender Registration - Retroactive Application**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the registration of certain sex offenders and other
4 offenders subject to registration requirements to be applied retroactively under
5 certain circumstances; making the provisions of this Act severable; and
6 generally relating to registration of sex offenders and other offenders.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Criminal Procedure**

15 11-702.1.

16 (A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY,
17 EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THIS SUBTITLE SHALL
18 BE APPLIED RETROACTIVELY TO INCLUDE A REGISTRANT CONVICTED OF AN
19 OFFENSE COMMITTED ~~ON OR~~ BEFORE JULY 1, 1997, AND WHO IS UNDER THE
20 CUSTODY OR SUPERVISION OF A SUPERVISING AUTHORITY ON OCTOBER 1, 2001.

21 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY,
22 THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE APPLIED RETROACTIVELY TO A CHILD SEXUAL OFFENDER

1 WHO COMMITTED THE SEXUAL OFFENSE ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 1995, AND WHO
2 IS UNDER THE CUSTODY OR SUPERVISION OF A SUPERVISING AUTHORITY ON
3 OCTOBER 1, 2001.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That if any provision of this
5 Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any
6 reason in a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity does not affect other
7 provisions or any other application of this Act which can be given effect without the
8 invalid provision or application, and for this purpose the provisions of this Act are
9 declared severable.

10 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2001.
