- 3 FOR the purpose of expanding the adoption search, contact, and reunion services
- 4 program within the Social Services Administration to include services to siblings
- of adopted individuals; authorizing a sibling of an adopted individual to apply to
- 6 receive adoption search, contact, and reunion services under certain
- 7 circumstances; requiring a confidential intermediary to attempt to contact a

- 1 5-4B-05. 2 (a) An individual who applies for search, contact, and reunion services shall 3 execute a written agreement with a confidential intermediary concerning the 4 provision of search, contact, and reunion services. 5 The confidential intermediary may charge the individual a 6 reasonable fee for search, contact, and reunion services. 7 The overall amount of fees collected may not exceed the costs of (2) 8 providing the services. 9 The confidential intermediary shall promptly: (c) 10 (1) file the executed agreement with the Director; and 11 (2) attempt to contact [either] the adopted individual [or], the 12 biological parent, OR THE SIBLING sought by the applicant. 13 5-4B-12. 14 The Director shall adopt regulations to implement the provisions of this subtitle, 15 including regulations concerning: 16 the application process for search, contact, and reunion services; (1) 17 (2) qualifications for a confidential intermediary; 18 (3) the agreement for search, contact, and reunion services executed by a 19 confidential intermediary and an adopted individual [or], biological parent, OR 20 SIBLING; and
