1 **Article - Environment** 2 9-343. 3 (a) A person who violates any provision of or fails to perform any duty (1) 4 imposed by this subtitle, or who violates any provision of or fails to perform any duty 5 imposed by a rule, regulation, order, or permit adopted or issued under this subtitle, 6 is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to: 7 For a first offense, a fine not exceeding \$25,000 or 8 imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or both; or 9 (ii) If the conviction is for a violation committed after a first 10 conviction of the person under this subsection, a fine not exceeding \$50,000 for each day of violation or imprisonment not exceeding 2 years or both. 12 (2) In addition to any criminal penalties imposed on a person convicted 13 under this subsection, the person may be enjoined from continuing the violation. 14 Each day on which a violation occurs is a separate violation under (3) 15 this subsection.
