- 23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 24 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 Article 33 - Election Code 2 4-203. 3 (c) [Except as provided in paragraph (2)(i) of this subsection, in] IN (1) 4 Baltimore County, members of the [party central committees] DEMOCRATIC PARTY 5 CENTRAL COMMITTEE may not run at large. Except for the Chairman, the members of the Republican Party 6 [(2)](i) 7 Central Committee shall be elected from the legislative districts of Baltimore County 8 as follows: 1. Three members shall be elected from any legislative 10 district that comprises 66% or more of its population within Baltimore County; 2. Two members shall be elected from any district which 12 comprises more than 33% but less than 66% of its population within Baltimore 13 County; 14 3. One member shall be elected from any legislative district 15 which comprises 33% or less of its population within Baltimore County; and In any legislative district that is divided into delegate 4. 16 districts and the delegate districts are located entirely within Baltimore County: 18 One member shall be elected from a single member A. 19 delegate district; and 20 B. Two members shall be elected from a two member delegate 21 district. 22 (ii) The Chairman shall be elected at large. 23 The number of Republican Party Central Committee (iii) 1. 24 members to be elected from each legislative district and each delegate district shall be determined upon completion of each legislative districting. The percentage of Baltimore County's population of a 27 legislative district shall be determined by the most recent United States census.] 28 THE REPUBLICAN PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIST OF: (2) TWO MEMBERS ELECTED FROM EACH COUNCILMANIC 29 (I)30 DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY: AND 31 FOUR MEMBERS ELECTED FROM THE COUNTY AT LARGE, (II)32 INCLUDING THE CHAIRMAN. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
