- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (b) (1) In a county that has adopted a charter under Article XI-A of the
- 18 Maryland Constitution OR IN A COUNTY IN WESTERN MARYLAND THAT HAS
- 19 ADOPTED CODE HOME RULE UNDER ARTICLE XI-F OF THE MARYLAND
- 20 CONSTITUTION, the county council OR THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, by
- 21 resolution or law, may provide for the appointment of a qualified individual as
- 22 managing official of the local correctional facility and for qualified assistants
- 23 necessary to perform the duties of that office.
- 24 (2) A managing official is responsible for the safekeeping, care, and
- 25 feeding of inmates in the custody of a local correctional facility, including an inmate
- 26 who is working on the public highways or going to and from that work, until the
- 27 inmate is discharged, released, or withdrawn from the local correctional facility by
- 28 due course of law.

- 1 (3) Except as specifically provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, 2 this subsection does not affect the powers and duties of the sheriff of a county relating
- 3 to custody and safekeeping of inmates.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 5 October 1, 2001.
