1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Western Maryland - Local Correctional Facility Officials - Appointment by**
3 **Code Home Rule Counties**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the board of county commissioners in a county in
5 Western Maryland that has adopted code home rule to provide for the
6 appointment of a managing official and necessary assistants for the local
7 correctional facility; and generally relating to local correctional facilities.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Correctional Services**

16 11-201.

17 (b) (1) In a county that has adopted a charter under Article XI-A of the
18 Maryland Constitution OR IN A COUNTY IN WESTERN MARYLAND THAT HAS
19 ADOPTED CODE HOME RULE UNDER ARTICLE XI-F OF THE MARYLAND
20 CONSTITUTION, the county council OR THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, by
21 resolution or law, may provide for the appointment of a qualified individual as
22 managing official of the local correctional facility and for qualified assistants
23 necessary to perform the duties of that office.

1 (2) A managing official is responsible for the safekeeping, care, and
2 feeding of inmates in the custody of a local correctional facility, including an inmate
3 who is working on the public highways or going to and from that work, until the
4 inmate is discharged, released, or withdrawn from the local correctional facility by
5 due course of law.

6 (3) Except as specifically provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection,
7 this subsection does not affect the powers and duties of the sheriff of a county relating
8 to custody and safekeeping of inmates.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2001.
