19 A 20 C 21 re 22 m	(b) (1) In a county that has adopted a charter under Article XI-A of the Maryland Constitution OR IN A COUNTY IN WESTERN MARYLAND THAT HAS DOPTED CODE HOME RULE UNDER ARTICLE XI-F OF THE MARYLAND ONSTITUTION, the county council OR THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, by esolution or law, may provide for the appointment of a qualified individual as managing official of the local correctional facility and for qualified assistants eccessary to perform the duties of that office.

- 1 (2) A managing official is responsible for the safekeeping, care, and
- 2 feeding of inmates in the custody of a local correctional facility, including an inmate
- 3 who is working on the public highways or going to and from that work, until the
- 4 inmate is discharged, released, or withdrawn from the local correctional facility by
