- 3 (a) An associate real estate broker or a real estate salesperson who obtains
- 4 trust money while providing real estate brokerage services promptly shall submit the
- 5 trust money to the real estate broker on whose behalf the associate real estate broker
- 6 or the real estate salesperson provided the real estate brokerage services.
- 7 (b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (c) of this section, a real
- 8 estate broker [promptly] PROMPTLY, WITHIN BUT NOT MORE THAN 3 7 BUSINESS
- 9 DAYS AFTER THE ACCEPTANCE OF A CONTRACT OF SALE BY BOTH PARTIES, shall
- 10 deposit trust money in an account that is maintained by the real estate broker:
- 11 (i) separately from the real estate broker's own accounts; and
- 12 (ii) solely for trust money.
- 13 (2) A real estate broker may not use trust money for any purpose other 14 than that for which it is entrusted to the real estate broker.
