18 (A) THE SECRETARY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE ASSOCIATION OF
19 MARYLAND HOSPITALS AND HEALTH SYSTEMS AND THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION
20 OF HOSPITAL SECURITY AND SAFETY DIRECTORS, SHALL DEVELOP A UNIFORM SET
21 OF SECURITY CODES FOR HOSPITALS.

22 (B) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 23 UNIFORM SET OF SECURITY CODES.
