- 8 ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE HOLDER OF A SPECIAL FESTIVAL LICENSE
- 9 TO DELIVER BEER AND WINE 2 DAYS PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE, AND TO
- 10 ACCEPT RETURNS 2 DAYS AFTER THE EXPIRATION DATE, OF THE SPECIAL FESTIVAL

- 12 (I) THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD SHALL ADOPT
