20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 3 (k) The provisions of §§ 22-403 and 22-405 of this subtitle do not apply to:
- 4 (1) [An information/computer] COMPUTER INFORMATION OR A
- 5 COMPUTER program provided for no fee, unless the [information/computer]
- 6 COMPUTER INFORMATION OR COMPUTER program is provided in conjunction with
- 7 the sale or lease of goods, services, [or another information/program] OTHER
- 8 COMPUTER INFORMATION, OR ANOTHER COMPUTER PROGRAM; or
- 9 (2) [An information/computer] COMPUTER INFORMATION OR A
- 10 COMPUTER program provided as a beta test or similar experimental version of the
- 11 [information/computer] COMPUTER INFORMATION OR COMPUTER program.
- 12 (L) THE PROVISIONS OF § 22-403 OF THIS SUBTITLE DO NOT APPLY TO A
- 13 COMPUTER PROGRAM PROVIDED UNDER A LICENSE THAT DOES NOT IMPOSE A
- 14 LICENSE FEE FOR THE RIGHT TO THE SOURCE CODE, TO MAKE COPIES, TO MODIFY,
- 15 AND TO DISTRIBUTE THE COMPUTER PROGRAM.
- 16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 17 June 1, 2001.
