BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions 13 14 9-602. Anne Arundel County may impose, by ordinance, and collect a sales or use 15 (a) 16 tax on: 17 (1)Fuels and utilities used by commercial and industrial businesses; Residential, commercial, and industrial telephone service; [and] 18 (2)19 Space rentals; AND (3)RENTAL CARS AT BALTIMORE-WASHINGTON INTERNATIONAL 20 (4)21 AIRPORT.

- 22 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, any revenues
- 23 collected under the authority of this section within the boundaries of the City of
- 24 Annapolis shall be allocated and distributed in equal amounts to the City of
- 25 Annapolis and to Anne Arundel County.

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1 (2) Any revenue generated within the boundaries of the City of 2 Annapolis from the tax on space rentals, including the tax on the room or building 3 rental tax for transients, shall be collected and retained by the City of Annapolis.

4 (c) On or after July 1, 1997, Anne Arundel County may not impose a sales and 5 use tax on space rentals for the docking or storage of boats.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 July 1, 2001.
