## 1 AN ACT concerning

# 2 District Court - Small Claim Actions

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the minimum amount in controversy in civil cases over
- 4 which the District Court of Maryland and the circuit courts have concurrent
- 5 jurisdiction; altering the amount of a small claim action in the District Court;
- 6 altering the amount in controversy in a civil action in the District Court in
- 7 which formal pleadings are prohibited; altering the minimum amount in
- 8 controversy in civil cases in which appeals from the District Court are required
- 9 to be heard on the record; providing for the application of this Act; and generally
- relating to small claim actions in the District Court.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### 18 Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

- 20 (d) (1) (i) Except in a case under paragraph (2), (4), (5), or (6) of § 4-401 of
- 21 this subtitle, the plaintiff may elect to file suit in the District Court or in a trial court
- 22 of general jurisdiction, if the amount in controversy exceeds [\$2,500] \$5,000, exclusive
- 23 of prejudgment or postjudgment interest, costs, and attorney's fees if attorney's fees
- 24 are recoverable by law or contract.
- 25 4-405.
- 26 The District Court has exclusive jurisdiction over a small claim action, which,
- 27 for purposes of this section, means a civil action for money in which the amount

- 1 claimed does not exceed [\$2,500] \$5,000 exclusive of interest, costs, and attorney's
- 2 fees, if attorney's fees are recoverable by law or contract; and landlord tenant action
- 3 under §§ 8-401 and 8-402 of the Real Property Article of the Code, in which the
- 4 amount of rent claimed does not exceed [\$2,500] \$5,000 exclusive of interest and
- 5 costs.
- 6 6-403.
- 7 (a) In a civil action in the District Court, if the amount in controversy is 8 [\$1,000] \$5,000 or less, there shall be no formal pleadings.
- 9 (b) If the amount in controversy exceeds [\$1,000] \$5,000 the forms and 10 pleadings are as provided by Title 3, Chapter 300 of the Maryland Rules.

- 12 (f) In a civil case in which the amount in controversy exceeds [\$2,500] \$5,000
- 13 exclusive of interest, costs, and attorney's fees if attorney's fees are recoverable by law
- 14 or contract, in any matter arising under § 4-401(7)(ii) of this article, and in any case
- 15 in which the parties so agree, an appeal shall be heard on the record made in the
- 16 District Court. In every other case, including a criminal case in which sentence has
- 17 been imposed or suspended following a plea of nolo contendere or guilty, and an
- 18 appeal in a municipal infraction or Code violation case, an appeal shall be tried de
- 19 novo.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 21 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
- 22 on or application to any civil action filed before the effective date of this Act.
- 23 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 October 1, 2001.
