A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Washington County - Exemption from Advertising Requirement for**
3 **Purchases for Covert Operations**

4 FOR the purpose of exempting from certain procurement provisions certain sales,
5 purchases, or expenditures by certain law enforcement personnel in Washington
6 County; requiring certain procurement records become public at a certain time;
7 and generally relating to the sales and purchases by law enforcement personnel
8 in Washington County.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 Section 1-106(c)
12 Article 22 - Public Local Laws of Maryland
13 (1991 Edition and December 1997 Supplement, as amended)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 22 - Washington County**

17 1-106.

18 (c) (1) Any contract entered into in violation of the provisions of this section
19 is void.

20 (2) (I) The provisions of this section do not apply to:

21 [(i)] 1. Any contract or other transaction involving the deposit of
22 county funds in any authorized State or federal banking institution;

23 [(ii)] 2. Necessary repairs made in case of emergency;

24 [(iii)] 3. The purchase of tangible personal property at a public
25 auction; [or]

1 [(iv)] 4. Any contract for which the County Commissioners
2 approve sole source procurement under §1-106.2 of this subtitle; OR

3 [(V)] 5. A CONTRACT OF SALE OR PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT OR A
4 CONTRACT FOR OTHER EXPENDITURES BY THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE, THE STATE'S
5 ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, OR THE NARCOTICS TASK FORCE FOR USE IN COVERT
6 OPERATIONS.

7 (II) ALL RECORDS MAINTAINED FOR A PROCUREMENT UNDER
8 PARAGRAPH (2)(I) 5 OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL REMAIN CONFIDENTIAL UNTIL THE
9 CONCLUSION OF THE COVERT OPERATION, AT WHICH TIME THE RECORDS WILL BE
10 MADE PUBLIC.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2001.
