3 FOR the purpose of providing that in Washington County certain individuals are

- 4 excluded from the population census count for the purpose of calculating the
- 5 population ratio quota that applies to the issuance of certain alcoholic beverages
- 6 licenses; and generally relating to the population ratio quota that applies to the
- 7 issuance of certain alcoholic beverages licenses in Washington County.

# 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
