- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 The inspectors in Anne Arundel County, FREDERICK COUNTY, Montgomery
- 22 County, and Prince George's County who investigate license violations under this
- 23 article may issue civil citations as provided in Article 27, § 402 of the Code.

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

- 3 (d) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection,
- 4 the alcoholic beverages inspectors in Anne Arundel County, FREDERICK COUNTY,
- 5 Montgomery County, and Prince George's County who investigate license violations
- 6 under Article 2B of the Code may issue citations as provided in subsections (a) and (b)
- 7 of this section only for the purpose of enforcing this subheading within their
- 8 respective jurisdictions.
- 9 (2) Before issuing citations under this section, alcoholic beverages
- 10 inspectors shall successfully complete an appropriate program of training in the
- 11 proper use of arrest authority and pertinent police procedure as required by the board
- 12 of license commissioners.
- 13 (3) Alcoholic beverages inspectors may not carry firearms in the 14 performance of their duties.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 2001.
