A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Washington County - Board of License Commissioners - Members**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the number of members on the Washington County
4 Board of License Commissioners; altering the number of members on the
5 Washington County Board of License Commissioners representing the same
6 political party; requiring certain members of the Washington County Board of
7 License Commissioners to have certain familiarity or experience; and generally
8 relating to the membership of the Washington County Board of License
9 Commissioners.

11 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

14 (1998 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

18 15-101.

19 (w) (1) The provisions of this subsection apply only in Washington County.

20 (2) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS CONSISTS OF FIVE
21 MEMBERS.

22 [(2)] (3) All terms shall be for 6 years and the terms of the members are
23 staggered as required by the terms of the members of the Board on January 1, 1994.

24 [(3)] (4) No more than [two] THREE of the appointees shall belong to the
25 same political party.

1 (5) AT LEAST ONE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS SHALL HAVE SOME
2 FAMILIARITY OR EXPERIENCE WITH THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES INDUSTRY PRIOR
3 TO THE TIME OF APPOINTMENT.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 October 1, 2001.
