# 1 AN ACT concerning

# 2 Vehicle Laws - Towing - Persons with a Disability

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the towing of a vehicle lawfully displaying a special
- 4 registration plate for a person with a disability, a parking placard for a person
- 5 with a disability, or a temporary parking placard for a person with a disability
- 6 under certain circumstances; providing that a local ordinance regulating
- 7 parking may not authorize the towing of a vehicle lawfully displaying special
- 8 registration plates or a parking placard issued for a person with a disability
- 9 unless the vehicle is an abandoned vehicle under certain provisions of law;
- 10 exempting a vehicle lawfully displaying special registration plates or a parking
- placard issued for a person with a disability from provisions of law authorizing
- the towing of certain vehicles from parking lots in Baltimore City and Baltimore
- 13 County; and generally relating to the towing of a vehicle displaying a special
- registration plate for a person with a disability, a parking placard for a person
- with a disability, or a temporary parking placard for a person with a disability.

- 26 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 27 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### 1 **Article - Transportation** 2 13-616. 3 The person for whom special registration plates are issued under this (g) (2) section or under a similar provision of any other state or country: 5 Except as provided in items (ii) and (iii) of this paragraph, 1. (i) 6 may park for unlimited periods in parking zones restricted as to the length of parking 7 time permitted; [and] 8 Is not required to pay any parking meter fees of this State 2. 9 or of any political subdivision of this State where parking meters do not meet the 10 Americans with Disabilities Act; AND 11 EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER TITLE 25, SUBTITLE 2 OF 12 THIS ARTICLE, IS NOT SUBJECT TO STATE OR LOCAL PROVISIONS AUTHORIZING THE 13 TOWING OF A VEHICLE; 14 May park in a parking space equipped with a parking meter (ii) 15 only for: 1. Except as provided in item (ii)2 of this paragraph, twice 16 17 the maximum time period permitted on the parking meter but not to exceed a 18 maximum of 4 hours; and If the parking meter permits parking for more than 4 19 2. 20 hours, the period permitted on the parking meter; and Subject to the posted time restriction specified for this parking 21 (iii) 22 zone, may park in a designated zone for the handicapped established at any 23 State-owned airport. 24 The provisions of this subsection supersede any local ordinance, (3) (I) except that they do not apply: 25 26 1. To zones where stopping, standing, or parking is [(i)]27 prohibited to all vehicles; 28 2. To zones that are reserved for special types of vehicles; or [(ii)]29 3. Where there is a local ordinance that prohibits parking [(iii)]30 during heavy traffic periods in morning, afternoon, or evening rush hours, or where 31 parking clearly would present a traffic hazard. 32 UNLESS THE VEHICLE IS AN ABANDONED VEHICLE UNDER 33 TITLE 25, SUBTITLE 2 OF THIS ARTICLE, A LOCAL ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING MAY NOT AUTHORIZE THE TOWING OF THE VEHICLE IF IT IS LAWFULLY DISPLAYING: 35 1. A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS 36 SECTION;
