SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 2001, contingent on the failure of S.B. 659 and H.B. 766 during the 2001 Session of the General Assembly. If Chapter (S.B. 659/H.B. 766) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2001 becomes effective, Section 2 of this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.

SECTION 3. 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 3 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 2001, contingent on the taking effect of Chapter _____ (S.B. _____ (1lr2038)/H.B. _____ (1lr2039)) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2001, and if Chapter _____ does not become effective, Section 2 3 of this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.
