A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County - Elected Board of Education Members - Term Limits**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the term limit provision that applies to members of the
4 Frederick County Board of Education; and generally relating to the Frederick
5 County Board of Education.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Education**

14 3-5A-01.

15 (c) (1) A member serves for a term of 4 years beginning the first Tuesday in
16 December after the member's election and until a successor is elected and qualifies.

17 (2) Members of the Frederick County Board shall be elected as follows:

18 (i) Three members of the County Board shall be elected in the
19 November general election of 2000 and every 4 years thereafter; and

20 (ii) Four members of the County Board shall be elected in the
21 November general election of 2002 and every 4 years thereafter.

22 [(3) An individual may not serve for more than two consecutive terms.]

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
24 effect July 1, 2001.
