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CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Maryland 4-H Facilities

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- 4 \$820,000 \$400,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors
- 5 of the Maryland 4-H Foundation, Inc. for certain development or improvement
- 6 purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a
- 7 requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and
- 8 providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10 MARYLAND, That:

- 11 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 12 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Maryland
- 13 4-H Facilities Loan of 2001 in the total principal amount of \$820,000 \$400,000. This
- 14 loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation
- 15 bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and
- 16 delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
- 17 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 18 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 19 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 20 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 21 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 22 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 23 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then

- 1 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 2 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 3 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Maryland
- 4 4-H Foundation, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the
- 5 construction, renovation, and capital equipping of facilities at the following 4-H
- 6 educational camping locations:
- 7 Prince George's County Patuxent River 4-H Center
- 8 construction of cabin interior including basement
- 9 Harford County 4-H Camp at The Rocks
- design, construction, and capital equipping of multipurpose building
- 11 Garrett County Western Maryland 4-H Center
- 12 renovation of buildings to allow year-round programming
- 13 Dorchester County Thendara 4-H Center
- renovation and capital equipping of Center's main building
- 15 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 16 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 17 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 18 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 19 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 20 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 21 matching fund of \$246,000. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided,
- 22 either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 23 unappropriated. The fund may consist of funds expended prior to the effective date of
- 24 this Act, real property, and in-kind contributions. In case of any dispute as to the
- 25 amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds,
- 26 the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is
- 27 final. The grantee has until June 1, 2003, to present evidence satisfactory to the
- 28 Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence
- 29 is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds
- 30 of the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act.
- 31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That this Act shall take effect
- 32 June 1, 2001.
