3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain insurers, nonprofit health service plans, health

4 maintenance organizations, and managed care organizations, and carriers to

5 provide coverage for the expenses incurred by certain obese patients for *certain*

6 surgical treatment under certain circumstances; authorizing certain benefits to

7 be provided through a managed care system; of morbid obesity as recognized by

8 <u>a certain entity; requiring the coverage of morbid obesity to be provided to the</u> 9 <u>same extent as *for* other medically necessary surgical procedures; defining</u>

10 WHEREAS, Severe or morbid obesity increases the mortality rate more than

- 11 threefold, causes physical and emotional disability, is often associated with comorbid
- 12 conditions compounding its adverse impact on longevity and quality of life, and is
- 13 amenable to established surgical treatment; and

14 WHEREAS, Like other chronic diseases, obesity is caused or aggravated by

15 many factors including genetics, behavior, metabolism, and environment, certain

16 therapeutic interventions can alter its course and severity, and therefore, obesity

17 should be treated for purposes of insurance like other medical conditions; and

WHEREAS, Health insurance policies commonly exclude coverage for the
 treatment of obesity, even when severe or morbid and complicated by comorbid
 conditions; now, therefore,

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

9 (RR) THE PROVISIONS OF § 15-837 OF THE INSURANCE ARTICLE APPLY TO 10 HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS.
