- 2 Creation of a State Debt Wicomico County Salisbury Rotary Scout and Community Center
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$350,000,
- 5 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the Rotary Club of
- 6 Salisbury Foundation, Inc. for certain development or improvement purposes;
- 7 providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that
- 8 the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for
- 9 the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.
- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That:
- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Wicomico
- 14 County Salisbury Rotary Scout and Community Center Loan of 2001 in a total
- 15 principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$350,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching
- 16 fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by

- 17 the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a 18 resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance
- 19 with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and
- 20 Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 21 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 22 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 23 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 24 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 25 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 26 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 27 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 28 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 29 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the Rotary Club
- 30 of Salisbury Foundation, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for
- 31 the construction and capital equipping of a scouting and community center facility

- 1 located at 1715 Riverside Drive in Salisbury to be built around the commemorative
- 2 fireplace and chimney of the original district scout center structure.
- 3 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 4 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 5 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 6 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 7 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 8 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 9 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 10 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 11 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property. The matching fund
- 12 may consist of in kind contributions and funds expended prior to the effective date of
- 13 this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money
- 14 or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine
- 15 the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2003, to
- 16 present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will
- 17 be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and
- 18 the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan
- 19 equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided
- 20 in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund
- 21 certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 June 1, 2001.
