#### CHAPTER\_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Circuit Courts - Funding of Law Clerks <del>and Rental of Space for Clerks of Court</del>

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Administrative Office of the Courts to pay

5 counties rent for certain space in county facilities occupied by the clerks of the

6 circuit courts, as provided in certain agreements approved by the Board of

7 Public Works; prohibiting an agreement for rental from exceeding a certain

8 amount and including certain provisions; prohibiting a county from decreasing

9 the space allocated to the clerk of the circuit court below a certain amount;

10 requiring each circuit court judge to have a law clerk employed by the State;

11 requiring certain appropriations <u>funds</u> to be included in the State budget;

12 requiring counties *and Baltimore City* to use the savings from this Act for circuit

13 court or related public safety purposes; requiring reports on certain

14 expenditures; providing for the construction and application of this Act;

15 providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to State funding of

16 circuit court operations.

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

7 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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# **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

(A) THERE SHALL BE INCLUDED IN EACH STATE BUDGET AN APPROPRIATION
 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT NECESSARY
 <u>THE BUDGET FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS SHALL INCLUDE</u>
 <u>FUNDS</u> TO PAY COUNTIES RENTAL <u>RENT TO COUNTIES</u> FOR SPACE OCCUPIED IN
 COUNTY FACILITIES BY CLERKS OF THE CIRCUIT COURTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH
 THIS SECTION.

16(B)TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET, THE DEPARTMENT OF17GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS SHALL PAY RENT18A COUNTY RENTAL UNDER THIS SECTION AT THE RATE NEGOTIATED WITH THE19COUNTY AND APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.

20(C)(1)AN AGREEMENT FOR RENTAL THE RENT NEGOTIATED UNDER THIS21SECTION MAY NOT EXCEED \$10 PER NET USABLE SQUARE FOOT AND.

22<u>AN AGREEMENT FOR RENT</u> MAY NOT INCLUDE ANY PROVISION FOR23SEPARATE REIMBURSEMENT OF MAINTENANCE AND UTILITY COSTS.

24 (D) A COUNTY MAY NOT DECREASE THE SPACE <u>NET USABLE SQUARE</u>

25 <u>FOOTAGE</u> ALLOCATED TO THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE COUNTY
 26 <u>BELOW THE SPACE NET USABLE SQUARE FOOTAGE</u> ALLOCATED FOR FISCAL YEAR

29 (A) EACH CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE SHALL HAVE ONE LAW CLERK, TO BE 30 EMPLOYED BY THE STATE.

(B) THERE SHALL BE INCLUDED IN EACH STATE BUDGET AN APPROPRIATION
TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS IN AN AMOUNT NECESSARY TO
THE BUDGET FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS SHALL INCLUDE
FUNDS TO EMPLOY ONE LAW CLERK FOR EACH CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE, AT A SALARY
AND WITH THE BENEFITS WITHIN A RANGE PROPOSED BY THE CONFERENCE OF
CIRCUIT JUDGES TO THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS.

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1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act does not relieve

2 any county, including Baltimore City, of its duty, before or after the effective date of

3 this Act, to provide space for the circuit court for the county and court related

4 agencies.

5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be
6 construed to assume any liability incurred by any county or Baltimore City in
7 connection with space occupied by the circuit court for the county or City or by a
8 court related agency.

9 SECTION 4. does not, except as specifically provided in this Act, modify any
 10 existing duty or liability of the State, a county, or Baltimore City.

11 <u>SECTION 3. 2.</u> AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

12 (1) Beginning in fiscal year 2002 2003 and each fiscal year thereafter, each 13 county and Baltimore City shall use the local fiscal savings resulting from this Act 14 solely to increase local expenditures for circuit court or related public safety purposes;

(2) In fiscal years 2002 through 2009 2003 through 2010, each county and
Baltimore City shall report to the Department of Budget and Management on or
before November 1 on circuit court or related public safety expenditures to which the
savings resulting from this Act have been applied. The Department of Budget and
Management shall report these expenditures to the Chief Judge of the Court of
Appeals and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the General
Assembly; and

(3) Circuit court or related public safety expenditures required under this
 section shall be used to supplement and may not supplant existing local expenditures
 for the same purpose.

25 SECTION 5. <u>4.</u> <u>3.</u> AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply

26 only to a law clerk hired on or after July 1, 2001 and not to a law clerk employed by

27 a circuit court judge on or before June 30, 2001, if a county or Baltimore City provides

28 <u>a salary to a law clerk employed before July 1, 2002 that is greater than the State</u>

29 <u>salary provided to the law clerk by the State, the county or Baltimore City shall</u>

30 supplement the State salary in an amount sufficient to maintain the annual salary

31 the law clerk received prior to the effective date of this Act. A county or Baltimore City

32 is not required to supplement the salary of a law clerk hired after the effective date of

33 this Act this Act shall only apply to a law clerk who begins employment on or after the
 34 effective date of this Act.

35 SECTION <u>6. <u>5.</u> <u>4.</u> AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 36 effect July 1, <del>2001</del> <u>2002</u>.</u>

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
