- 2 Circuit Courts Funding of Law Clerks and Rental of Space for Clerks of Court
- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State to pay counties rent for certain space in
- 5 county facilities occupied by the clerks of the circuit courts, as provided in
- 6 certain agreements approved by the Board of Public Works; prohibiting an
- 7 agreement for rental from exceeding a certain amount and including certain
- 8 provisions; prohibiting a county from decreasing the space allocated to the clerk
- 9 of the circuit court; requiring each circuit court judge to have a law clerk
- employed by the State; requiring certain appropriations to be included in the
- 11 State budget; requiring counties to use the savings from this Act for circuit court
- or related public safety purposes; requiring reports on certain expenditures;
- providing for the construction and application of this Act; and generally relating
- to State funding of circuit court operations.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 22 Article Courts and Judicial Proceedings
- 23 1-504.
- 24 (A) THERE SHALL BE INCLUDED IN EACH STATE BUDGET AN APPROPRIATION
- 25 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT NECESSARY
- 26 TO PAY COUNTIES RENTAL FOR SPACE OCCUPIED IN COUNTY FACILITIES BY CLERKS
- 27 OF THE CIRCUIT COURTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.
- 28 (B) TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET, THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 29 GENERAL SERVICES SHALL PAY TO A COUNTY RENTAL UNDER THIS SECTION AT THE

- 1 RATE NEGOTIATED WITH THE COUNTY AND APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC
- 2 WORKS.
- 3 (C) AN AGREEMENT FOR RENTAL UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT EXCEED \$10
- 4 PER NET USABLE SQUARE FOOT AND MAY NOT INCLUDE ANY PROVISION FOR
- 5 SEPARATE REIMBURSEMENT OF MAINTENANCE AND UTILITY COSTS.
- 6 (D) A COUNTY MAY NOT DECREASE THE SPACE ALLOCATED TO THE CLERK OF
- 7 THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE COUNTY BELOW THE SPACE ALLOCATED FOR FISCAL
- 8 YEAR 2000.

- 10 (A) EACH CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE SHALL HAVE ONE LAW CLERK, TO BE 11 EMPLOYED BY THE STATE.
- 12 (B) THERE SHALL BE INCLUDED IN EACH STATE BUDGET AN APPROPRIATION
- 13 TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS IN AN AMOUNT NECESSARY TO
- 14 EMPLOY ONE LAW CLERK FOR EACH CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE, AT A SALARY AND WITH
- 15 THE BENEFITS WITHIN A RANGE PROPOSED BY THE CONFERENCE OF CIRCUIT
- 16 JUDGES TO THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS.
- 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act does not relieve
- 18 any county, including Baltimore City, of its duty, before or after the effective date of
- 19 this Act, to provide space for the circuit court for the county and court-related
- 20 agencies.
- 21 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be
- 22 construed to assume any liability incurred by any county or Baltimore City in
- 23 connection with space occupied by the circuit court for the county or City or by a
- 24 court-related agency.
- 25 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:
- 26 (1) Beginning in fiscal year 2002 and each fiscal year thereafter, each county
- 27 and Baltimore City shall use the local fiscal savings resulting from this Act solely to
- 28 increase local expenditures for circuit court or related public safety purposes;
- 29 (2) In fiscal years 2002 through 2009, each county and Baltimore City shall
- 30 report to the Department of Budget and Management on or before November 1 on
- 31 circuit court or related public safety expenditures to which the savings resulting from
- 32 this Act have been applied. The Department of Budget and Management shall report
- 33 these expenditures to the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals; and
- 34 (3) Circuit court or related public safety expenditures required under this
- 35 section shall be used to supplement and may not supplant existing local expenditures
- 36 for the same purpose.

- SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply only to a law clerk hired on or after July 1, 2001 and not to a law clerk employed by a circuit court judge on or before June 30, 2001.

- SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 5 July 1, 2001.
