A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Cosmetologists - Temporary License**

3 FOR the purpose of creating a temporary license under the State Board of
4 Cosmetology; requiring the Board to issue a temporary license under certain
5 circumstances; authorizing the holder of a temporary license to practice
6 cosmetology under certain circumstances; providing for the expiration of a
7 temporary license; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally
8 relating to temporary licenses and the State Board of Cosmetology.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions**

22 5-101.

23 (g) (1) "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license
24 issued by the Board.

25 (2) "License" includes, unless the context requires otherwise, each of the
26 following licenses:

27 (i) a license to practice cosmetology;

- 1 (ii) a license to practice as a senior cosmetologist;
- 2 (iii) a limited license to provide makeup artist services;
- 3 (iv) a limited license to provide esthetic services; [and]
- 4 (v) a limited license to provide nail technician services; AND
- 5 (VI) A TEMPORARY LICENSE.

7 (A) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE
8 A TEMPORARY LICENSE TO PRACTICE COSMETOLOGY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS
9 WAITING TO TAKE A LICENSING EXAMINATION UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

10 (B) THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A TEMPORARY LICENSE ONLY TO AN
11 INDIVIDUAL WHO:

- 12 (1) EXCEPT FOR TAKING AND PASSING AN EXAMINATION UNDER THIS
13 SUBTITLE, OTHERWISE QUALIFIES FOR A LICENSE TO PRACTICE COSMETOLOGY;
- 14 (2) SUBMITS TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE
15 BOARD PROVIDES; AND
- 16 (3) PAYS TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION FEE ESTABLISHED BY THE
17 BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 5-205 OF THIS TITLE.

18 (C) THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE THE TEMPORARY LICENSE AT THE TIME THE
19 APPLICANT RECEIVES NOTICE OF THE RELEVANT EXAMINATION DATE.

20 (D) WHILE A TEMPORARY LICENSE IS IN EFFECT, IT AUTHORIZES THE
21 HOLDER TO PRACTICE COSMETOLOGY UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED
22 COSMETOLOGIST.

23 (E) A TEMPORARY LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE EARLIER OF:

- 24 (1) 120 DAYS AFTER THE ISSUANCE OF THE TEMPORARY LICENSE;
- 25 (2) THE FAILURE OF THE HOLDER OF THE TEMPORARY LICENSE TO
26 TAKE A SCHEDULED EXAMINATION WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE ISSUANCE OF THE
27 TEMPORARY LICENSE;
- 28 (3) NOTICE BY THE BOARD THAT THE APPLICANT HAS FAILED THE
29 EXAMINATION; OR
- 30 (4) ISSUANCE UNDER THIS TITLE OF A LICENSE TO PRACTICE
31 COSMETOLOGY OR A LIMITED LICENSE.

32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
33 October 1, 2001. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of

- 1 September 30, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this
- 2 Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
