- 18 (A) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE SECRETARY SHALL
- 19 PREPARE A REPORT THAT INCLUDES INFORMATION ABOUT THE USE OF ANTIBIOTICS
- 20 AND HORMONES IN AGRICULTURE. THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE:
- 21 (1) INFORMATION ABOUT ANTIBIOTICS AND HORMONES GIVEN
- 22 THROUGH FEED, THROUGH DIRECT ADMINISTRATION, OR BY ANY OTHER MEANS TO
- 23 ANIMALS RAISED TO BE USED FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION; AND

1 (B) FOR EACH ANTIBIOTIC AND HORMONE ROUTINELY GIVEN BY MEANS (1) 2 INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO FEED, WATER, SPRAY, OR INJECTION, THE 3 SECRETARY SHALL COLLECT THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION FOR INCLUSION IN 4 THE REPORT: THE GENERIC AND TRADE NAME OF THE ANTIBIOTIC OR (I) 6 HORMONE; 7 (II)THE METHOD OF ADMINISTRATION; (III)THE AMOUNT OF ANTIBIOTIC OR HORMONE PER UNIT OF FEED. 8 9 WATER, SPRAY, INJECTION, OR PER ANIMAL AS APPROPRIATE; 10 (IV) THE SPECIES OF ANIMAL THAT RECEIVED THE ANTIBIOTIC OR 11 HORMONE; AND 12 (V) THE REASON FOR ADMINISTRATION. THE SECRETARY WILL DETERMINE THE MOST APPROPRIATE 13 14 METHODS OF OBTAINING THESE DATA IN CONSULTATION WITH ANIMAL GROWERS, 15 SUPPLIERS, DISTRIBUTORS, AND RELEVANT EXPERTS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF 16 MARYLAND. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A VETERINARIAN TREATING A SINGLE 17 (C) 18 ANIMAL FOR INFECTION OR FOR OTHER PROBLEMS UNRELATED TO FEEDING 19 ISSUES. 20 (D) THE REPORT MAY NOT DISCLOSE THE ACTIONS OF ANY INDIVIDUAL WITH 21 RESPECT TO THE USE OF ANTIBIOTICS OR HORMONES IN AGRICULTURE. (E) 22 THE SECRETARY SHALL: 23 SUBMIT THE REPORT TO THE HOUSE ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS 24 COMMITTEE AND THE SENATE ECONOMIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS 25 COMMITTEE; AND SUBMIT THE REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND 26 (2)
