	WHEREAS, Some people with a mental disorder require ongoing mental health services, including treatment with psychotropic medications, in order to live safely in the community; and
18	WHEREAS, Some people who require ongoing mental health services experience periods when their symptoms worsen and they become incapable of making an informed decision about services and may discontinue needed services; and
22 23	WHEREAS, An advance directive for health care allows an individual, when capable of making an informed decision about health care, to specify services he or she would wish to receive if he or she became incapable of making such a decision in the future or to authorize an agent to make health care decisions on the individual's behalf in such a circumstance; and
