The annual scholarship award shall be in the amount of \$1,000 for a 6 (a) 7 student enrolled at a 2-year eligible institution or \$3,000 for a student enrolled in a 8 4-year eligible institution. 9 18-2306. 10 A recipient of an award made under this section shall receive the award for 11 each year indicated in which the recipient is eligible if the recipient signs an 12 agreement at the time of the initial award to: 13 Commence [employment in the State] PERFORMING THE (1) (I) 14 SERVICE OBLIGATION within 1 year after completion of undergraduate studies for 1 15 year for each year that the scholarship was awarded; OR IF THE RECIPIENT IS ENROLLED IN AN UNDERGRADUATE 16 (II)17 NURSING PROGRAM, COMMENCE PERFORMING THE SERVICE OBLIGATION AS A 18 REGISTERED NURSE OR A LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE WITHIN 1 YEAR AFTER 19 COMPLETION OF THE UNDERGRADUATE NURSING PROGRAM FOR 1 YEAR FOR EACH 20 YEAR THAT THE SCHOLARSHIP WAS AWARDED; and 21 Repay the State the amounts awarded under this subtitle as set forth 22 in § 18-112 of this title if the recipient does not: 23 Satisfy the degree requirements of the eligible institution or 24 fulfill other requirements as provided in this subtitle; and 25 Perform the service obligation [for 1 year for each year that the (ii) 26 recipient has a scholarship awarded under this subtitle] AS SPECIFIED UNDER ITEM 27 (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION. 28 The service obligation begins after graduation and cannot be fulfilled prior (e) 29 to graduation from an eligible institution. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 31 June 1, 2001.
