The Fund is a continuing, nonlapsing fund which is not subject to § 6 7-302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article. 7 Interest and earnings on the Fund shall be separately accounted for 9 and credited to the Fund, and are not subject to § 6-226(a) of the State Finance and 10 Procurement Article. 11 (c) The Fund consists of: 12 TRAFFIC CITATION SURCHARGES COLLECTED UNDER § 27-101.2 OF (1) 13 THIS ARTICLE AND § 7-301(G) OF THE COURTS ARTICLE; 14 Registration surcharges collected under § 13-954 of this subtitle; and (2) 15 All funds, including charges for accident scene transports and 16 interhospital transfers of patients, generated by an entity specified in subsection (e) of this section that is a unit of State government. Expenditures from the Fund shall be made pursuant to an appropriation 18 (d) 19 approved by the General Assembly in the annual State budget or by the budget 20 amendment procedure provided under § 7-209 of the State Finance and Procurement Article, provided that any budget amendment shall be submitted to and approved by 22 the Legislative Policy Committee prior to the expenditure or obligation of funds. 23 The money in the Fund shall be used solely for: (e) 24 Medically oriented functions of the Department of State Police, (1) 25 Special Operations Bureau, Aviation Division; (2) The Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems; 26 27 The R Adams Cowley Shock Trauma Center at the University of 28 Maryland Medical System; 29 (4) The Maryland Fire and Rescue Institute; 30 The provision of grants under the State Fire, Rescue, and Ambulance 31 Fund in accordance with the provisions of Article 38A, §§ 45A through 45D of the 32 Code; and
