Article 29 - Washington Suburban Sanitary District

- 3 (A) BY RESOLUTION OR REGULATION, THE WSSC MAY IMPLEMENT A LOCAL 4 SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM.
- 5 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO ASSIST SMALL BUSINESSES THAT
- 6 ARE LOCATED IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY THROUGH
- 7 THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SHELTERED MARKET OR OTHER APPROPRIATE
- 8 PREFERENCE OR ASSISTANCE INVOLVING THE AWARD OF CONSTRUCTION
- 9 CONTRACTS OR THE PROCUREMENT OF GOODS AND SERVICES BY THE WSSC.
- 10 (C) THE WSSC SHALL ADOPT:
- 11 (1) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR BUSINESSES TO QUALIFY FOR THE
- 12 LOCAL SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM, INCLUDING:
- 13 (I) A NET WORTH NOT EXCEEDING \$250,000 UNDER WSSC
- 14 GUIDELINES;
- 15 (II) AN AVERAGE NET INCOME AFTER FEDERAL INCOME TAXES
- 16 FOR THE PRECEDING 2 YEARS, EXCLUDING ANY CARRYOVER LOSSES, NOT
- 17 EXCEEDING \$100,000;
- 18 (III) A PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS OR SIGNIFICANT
- 19 EMPLOYMENT PRESENCE IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY OR PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY;

- 21 (IV) ANY OTHER ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA THAT THE WSSC
- 22 DETERMINES TO BE NECESSARY OR OTHERWISE APPROPRIATE FOR THE PROMOTION

- 24 (2) ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES FOR CONDUCTING THE PROGRAM.
- 25 (D) A BUSINESS ENTERPRISE MAY QUALIFY AS A LOCAL SMALL BUSINESS FOR
- 26 PURPOSES OF THE PROGRAM WITHOUT REGARD TO THE RACE, ETHNICITY, OR
- 27 GENDER OF THE PARTICIPANTS IN THE BUSINESS ENTERPRISE.
- 28 (E) THE WSSC SHALL ESTABLISH GRADUATION CRITERIA FROM THE
- 29 PROGRAM FOR LOCAL SMALL BUSINESSES THAT THE WSSC DETERMINES NO
- 30 LONGER REQUIRE THE ASSISTANCE OR BENEFITS OFFERED BY THE PROGRAM.
- 31 (F) THE WSSC SHALL REVIEW THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND
- 32 ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES OF THE PROGRAM EACH YEAR TO ASSESS THEIR
