16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

19 4-401.

20 Except as provided in § 4-402 of this subtitle, and subject to the venue
21 provisions of Title 6 of this article, the District Court has exclusive original civil
22 jurisdiction in:

23 (10) A proceeding for adjudication of:

24 (iv) A WSSC infraction as defined in Article 29, § 18-104.2 of the
25 Code, concerning WSSC regulations governing:

1 (v) Regulations governing required permits for public utility
2 construction, under authority of §§ 10-104 and 10-105 of this article.

3 (2) The regulations shall be published as provided in § 9-101(b) of this
4 article.

5 (3) The sworn certificate of any member of the WSSC of the publication
6 under this section is prima facie evidence of publication.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2001.
