19	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF		
20 M	ARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:		

1 Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission 2 8-112.4. 3 (a) This section applies to any land within the corporate limits of a municipal 4 corporation in the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's 5 County. 6 Subject to [paragraph] PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3) of this subsection, (1) (b) 7 the District Council may provide that the governing body of a municipal corporation 8 may exercise the powers of the District Council in regard to: 9 (i) Design standards; 10 (ii) **DETAILED SITE PLANS**; 11 (III)Parking and loading standards; 12 (IV) Sign design standards; {(iii)} 13 (V) Variances for lot size, setback requirements, and similar $\{(iv)\}$ 14 requirements; and 15 Landscaping requirements, INCLUDING REQUESTS FOR $\{(v)\}$ (VI)16 COMPLIANCE ALTERNATIVES FROM THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY LANDSCAPE 17 MANUAL. When exercising authority delegated under paragraph (1) of this 18 19 subsection, the governing body of a municipal corporation shall be subject to the 20 substantive and procedural requirements and standards established by the District 21 Council. 22 When exercising authority delegated under paragraph (1) of this 23 subsection, the governing body of a municipal corporation may not impose any 24 standard or requirement SUBSTANTIALLY different from standards or requirements 25 that would apply had the District Council not delegated its authority to the municipal 26 corporation. 27 Any party to an action of the governing body of a municipal corporation (c)

- 28 under this section shall have the same right of appeal to the circuit court as the party
- 29 would have if the action had been taken by the District Council.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 31 October 1, 2001.
