6	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (g) (1) [A final action by the Commission on any application for the
- 21 subdivision of land within 30 days after the action is taken by the Commission, may
- 22 be appealed by any] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, WITHIN 30
- 23 DAYS AFTER THE FINAL ACTION IS TAKEN, ANY person aggrieved by [the action] A
- 24 FINAL ACTION BY THE COMMISSION ON ANY APPLICATION FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF
- 25 LAND, or [by] any person, municipality, corporation or association, whether or not
- 26 incorporated, which has appeared at the hearing in person, by attorney or in
- 27 [writing] WRITING, MAY APPEAL THE FINAL ACTION to the circuit court for the
- 28 [county which] COUNTY. THE CIRCUIT COURT may affirm or reverse the action

- 1 appealed from, or remand it to the Commission for further consideration. When an
- 2 appeal is [filed] FILED, the procedures described in § 8-105(b) of this article shall [be
- 3 applicable] APPLY to the Commission and other parties as [is] appropriate.
- 4 (2) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, IF THE SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS
- 5 PROVIDE FOR AN APPEAL TO THE DISTRICT COUNCIL, A FINAL ACTION BY THE
- 6 COMMISSION ON AN APPLICATION FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF LAND MAY BE
- 7 APPEALED ONLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS. THE
