2 Frederick County - Lamar Sanitarium Historic Museum Loan of 1999

- 3 FOR the purpose of amending Chapter 225 of the Acts of the General Assembly of
- 4 1999, the Frederick County Lamar Sanitarium Historic Museum Loan of 1999,
- 5 to allow the grantee to provide a matching fund consisting of funds expended
- 6 prior to June 1, 1999; and generally relating to the Frederick County Lamar
- 7 Sanitarium Historic Museum Loan of 1999.
- 8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 9 Chapter 225 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1999
- 10 Section 1(5)
- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Chapter 225 of the Acts of 1999

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That:
- 16 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 17 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 18 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 19 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 20 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property[, in kind
- 21 contributions, or] OR IN KIND CONTRIBUTIONS. THE FUND MAY CONSIST OF funds
- 22 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount
- 23 of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the
- 24 Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final.
- 25 The grantee has until June 1, 2001, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of
- 26 Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is
- 27 presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to
- 28 the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching
- 29 fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan
- 30 in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works
- 50 in excess of the amount of the matching fund estimated by the Board of Fublic Works
- 31 shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 June 1, 2001.
