12 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A REQUEST MADE BY A PERSON FOR 13 THE PURPOSE OF MEETING A LEGAL REQUIREMENT THAT MANDATES USE OF A 14 SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 16 October 1, 2001.
