SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Family Law

14 5-553.

(a) For purposes of this Part V of this subtitle, a day care provider's own16 children under the age of 2 years shall be counted as children served.

17 (b) (1) At any given time, a day care provider may not care for more than 8 18 children, of whom no more than 4 may be under the age of 2 years.

19 (2) An adult to child ratio of at least 1 adult to every 2 children under the 20 age of [2 years] 18 MONTHS shall be maintained at all times.

21 (c) If the Department determines that the group size provisions of subsection

22 (b) of this section are unsuitable for a particular family day care home, the

23 Department may decrease the number of children permitted to be in care at that

24 family day care home.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 2001.
