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Executive Branch to evaluate responses from qualified offerors and authorizing 19 the unit to select the offeror's response that is the most advantageous to the

generally relating to adoption by the Secretary of a streamlined process for 21

procurement by units shall be by competitive sealed bids unless one of the following
methods specifically is authorized:

26 (2) In awarding a procurement contract for a lease of real property, the 27 preferred method is by competitive sealed proposals under § 13-105 of this subtitle.

28 (3) Procurement under an intergovernmental cooperative purchasing

29 agreement is appropriate in situations where the State is expected to achieve a better 30 price as the result of economies of scale or to otherwise benefit by purchasing in

31 cooperation with another governmental entity.

 APPROPRIATE CATEGORY ESTABLISHED BY THE SECRETARY.

17 (E) AFTER A UNIT OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH RECEIVES RESPONSES FROM
18 QUALIFIED OFFERORS TO A SOLICITATION FOR A TASK ORDER, THE UNIT SHALL
19 EVALUATE THE RESPONSES AND MAY SELECT AN OFFEROR BASED ON THE
20 RESPONSE THAT IS DETERMINED TO BE THE MOST ADVANTAGEOUS TO THE STATE
21 CONSIDERING THE EVALUATION FACTORS SET FORTH IN THE TASK ORDER.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 July 1, 2001.

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
