13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (a) [The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, THE

18 Department shall provide for care, diagnosis, training, education, and rehabilitation

19 of children by placing them in group homes and institutions that are operated by any20 nonprofit or for-profit entity.

(b) (1) The Department shall reimburse these entities for the cost of these
services at appropriate monthly rates that the Department determines, as provided in
the State budget.

24 (2) The reimbursement rate may differ between homes and institutions
25 that provide intermediate services, as defined by the Department, and homes and
26 institutions that provide full services.

(c) The Department may not place a child in a group home or other residentialfacility that is not operating in compliance with applicable State licensing laws.

(D) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT PLACE A CHILD IN A GROUP HOME OR OTHER
 RESIDENTIAL FACILITY IF THE CHILD HAS BEEN ADJUDICATED DELINQUENT FOR AN
 ACT THAT WOULD BE A VIOLATION OF ARTICLE 27, § 462, § 463, § 464A, § 464A, § 464B, §
 464C, OR § 464F OF THE CODE IF COMMITTED BY AN ADULT.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2001.
