Natural Resources - Methods for Catching Oysters and Spat

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to adopt certain
- 4 regulations that allow the use of certain methods to catch spat for aquaculture
- 5 purposes; requiring a person to use certain methods when catching oyster spat
- 6 in the waters of the State; authorizing a person to catch oysters or clams in
- 7 certain manners subject to regulations adopted by the Department; and
- 8 generally relating to catching oysters, clams, and spat.
- 9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (a) Subject to [restrictions promulgated] REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE
- 19 DEPARTMENT pursuant to this subtitle, a person may catch oysters or clams in the
- 20 waters of the State only by hand, rakes, tongs, patent tongs, diving apparatus,
- 21 dredges, AND [handscrapes,] HANDSCRAPES. [cultch material suspended on strings,
- 22 in trays, in bags, or similar devices.] Soft-shell clams may be caught by hydraulic or
- 23 mechanical dredges or rigs.
- 24 (b) The Department may make uniform the size and weight of patent tongs in
- 25 waters where patent tongs are permitted. However, any person using any size or
- 26 weight patent tongs on June 1, 1964, may continue to use them.
- 27 (c) A person may catch oyster spat in the waters of the State by METHODS IN
- 28 ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS PROMULGATED UNDER THIS SECTION

- 1 INCLUDING [suspended] means such as cultch material on strings, trays, bags, or 2 similar devices, [which do not touch the bottom and] WHICH do not interfere with
- 3 navigation.
- 4 (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS
- 5 SECTION THAT ALLOW THE FOLLOWING METHODS TO CATCH SPAT FOR
- 6 AQUACULTURE PURPOSES:
- 7 SUSPENDED DEVICES; AND (1)
- 8 (2) MATERIAL OR DEVICES PLACED ON THE BOTTOM.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 July 1, 2001.
