CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicle Administration - Driver Instruction over the Internet**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Motor Vehicle Administration, unless specifically
4 authorized by law, from offering or authorizing any driver instruction program
5 that is provided over the Internet; and providing for the termination of this Act.

9 Annotated Code of Maryland
10 (1999 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Transportation**

14 12-121.

15 UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED BY LAW, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT
16 OFFER OR AUTHORIZE ANY DRIVER INSTRUCTION PROGRAM THAT IS PROVIDED
17 OVER THE INTERNET.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2001. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of
20 September 30, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this
21 Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
