- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Transportation
- 14 12-121.
- 15 UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED BY LAW, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT
- 16 OFFER OR AUTHORIZE ANY DRIVER INSTRUCTION PROGRAM THAT IS PROVIDED
- 17 OVER THE INTERNET.
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 19 October 1, 2001. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of
- 20 September 30, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this
- 21 Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
